**Abstract**

**In the very recent past several groups in Europe have demonstrated long term peri-implant soft tissue problems leading to esthetic failures around Immediate Implants placed in extraction socket sites.**

**The same groups have suggested that they would opt for the staged placement protocol following socket healing.**

**Peri- implant soft and hard tissue problems following immediate implant placement can be attributed to a lack of complete understanding of the biologic and periodontal variables that would dictate the final longterm esthetic result.**

**It will be the presenters objective to discuss in detail with case examples the variables which can be controlled to achieve longterm predictable esthetics with immediate implant placement.**

**Surgical protocols, immediate provisionalisation and restorative options will also be discussed during the presentation.**
